Dying Taper, by Thomas Jarman, is taken from his Sacred Harmonicon, pub. ca 1840. Words by Thomas Kelly, an Irish cleric, previously a barrister. Kelly (1769-1855) published more than 700 of his hymns from the beginning of the 19th century.
